## A Sneak Peak at Microsoft Dynamics GP 11.0

Microsoft Dynamics GP 11.0 is slated for release mid-2010 and will include key new features like drilling down into data and customizing metrics. The focus according to Brian Meier, Microsoft Program Manager, is to simplify your data including the ability to investigate into data easier.

“If you have an issue, you will be able to drill back into that issue,” he said. “Instead of sorting through a spreadsheet, it is easier to see a high level and then be able to drill down into the areas that interest you.”

Customization will also be a key feature. Previously, in Dynamics GP version 10, the software was based on Office web components and had the ability to customize metrics. New options include using reporting service metrics. This gives you the option to create new reports.

“You will be able to build it once and share it across multiple applications,” he said. “We’ve also added the ability to see those metrics in your Dynamics GP list. Starting at a high level where you can see something is wrong; there will be drill back functionality so you can see more detail. And you can open the window and get into the client application window and drill down from there.”

Integration with Microsoft Office and Dynamics GP will also offer 22 “out-of-the-box” templates to be able to create and modify work in Word. The new version will support a multitude of templates for each Report Writer report. These templates can also be modified to create new templates or you can create a new template from a blank document.
