Tips and Tricks: Reversing Entries

In Microsoft Dynamics GP, reversing entries are made using the Transaction Entry window. To adjust transactions incorrectly posted in the General Ledger, the transaction must be reversed and reentered correctly. Reverse the transaction by selecting the standard transaction type and debiting the account that was originally credited and credit the account that was originally debited.
